<p>Purchase of new curriculum resources to support teaching and learning. £1000 was allocated to resources.</p> <p>Special Needs Advisory Staff support involved 6 visits during the academic year to support assessment and strategy development. £1530.00 was allocated to SNA support.</p> <p>Support for parents in meeting costs for school trips, residential visits and extra-curricular clubs and activities. Creation of uniform packs and homework support packs for pupils. £5,000 was allocated to relieving financial pressure on parents.</p> <p>Additional teaching assistant support in the classroom for small group booster/intervention programmes and additional pastoral support needs. The remainder of the PPG budget was allocated to additional support.</p>
