PUPIL CODE OF CONDUCT

As a pupil of Enstone Primary School I will:

- Behave in an orderly, self-controlled and safe way.
- Use good manners.
- Uphold the identified school values of RESPECT, KINDNESS, RESPONSIBILITY, GRATITUDE, TEAMWORK, HONESTY and PERSEVERANCE.
- Arrive at school on time for registration and all lessons.
- Act with dignity and show care and respect to others.
- Give my best effort to all learning opportunities.
- In class, make it possible for all pupils to learn.
- Move quietly and sensibly around the school.
- Treat the school buildings and school property - as well as the property of others - with respect.
- Stay inside the school boundaries during school time.
- Keep off the gates, railings and walls, and off the play equipment on the field.
- Never journey between school buildings unless accompanied by an adult.
- Wear the correct uniform (including PE kit) at all times with a good level of self-presentation.
- Bring items into school as needed (reading book with reading journal, PE kits, etc.)
- Complete tasks to deadlines (homework etc.)
- Be willing to enter into a sensible and honest restorative conversation when something has gone wrong. Understand that choices have consequences.
- Stick to the school's anti-bullying charter and say "NO" to bullying behaviour.

Parents, please:

- Name your child's uniform.
- Do not park at the front of the school; use the rear School Hall car park.
- In the event of absence, telephone or email the school office early on the first day.
- Do make an appointment with a member of staff if you wish to discuss any aspect of school life or your child's progress. Remember it takes time to discuss important issues fairly and clearly.
