

ONGOING LEARNING

There are lots of learning activities you can do on a daily basis that will really benefit your child.

Here are some suggestions for core areas of learning to keep on top of, especially if you are having trouble accessing or completing any of the daily activities set by class teachers.

Read every day. The ability to read fluently and understand and use what we read is the foundation for all other learning.

Teach your child to tell the time using an analogue clock (one with numbers and hands) and a digital clock.

Practise times tables up to 12X12 (depending on the age of your child).

For younger children, **practise counting** in 1s, 2s, 5s, and 10s and learn number bonds.

Practise spellings from your child's high frequency (key words) or year group spelling lists.
