All meetings will be from 3:15 – 4:00pm.

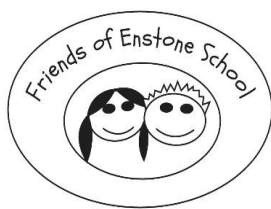
